



DID YOU KNOW...?

- Thomas Willet became the first *Mayor / President* of New York in the year 1665.
- In 1776 Benjamin Franklin, writer, scientist and politician, became the United States' first *ambassador* / *Prime Minister* to France.
- In 2009 Barack Obama became the first black President / member of the United States.
- Ellen Wilkinson, one of the first women Members / Ministers of Parliament in Britain, became the Minister /Ambassador of Education in 1945.
- Margaret Thatcher was the first and so far the only woman Prime Minister / Mayor of Britain.
