Ambulance Service

What should you say when calling 999?

When you phone the ambulance service, be prepared to give them the following information:

- The location where you are.
- Your name and the phone number you are calling from.
- Exactly what has happened, including details of the injury.
- The patient's age and sex, and anything you know about his/her illness.
- Is the patient conscious? Is he/she breathing?
Is there any serious bleeding?
